Instructions and Sample: The Figures Page

If you include figures, list them on a “Figures” page. The figures page should be the first page after the contents page. Since the contents page only lists material which follows it, your figures page, if you include one, will be the first item listed on your contents page. Be sure to consult [Turabian](#) (2007, 388-89 and Fig. A.6). See the sample figures page below.

**FIGURES**

**Type the word “Figures” centered at the top of the page. If the list is more than one page, do not repeat the title.**

**Leave two blank lines between the title and the first item listed.**

1. Christian Essentialism: The Creator/creature Distinction .....15
2. John Frame’s Square of Opposition .....26
3. Nature-Grace Dualism, Natural Law, and Natural Theology .....57
4. Poythress’ Triad of Meaning .....92

**Leader dots may be used, but they are not required.**

**Single space individual items, but leave a blank line between entries.**
