The Craig Center at Westminster Theological Seminary announces the establishment of three research fellowships to be awarded in October 2010.

Post-doctoral Research Fellowship

Eligibility: Ph.D. from WTS in the past 5 years.

Tenure of Fellowship: 1 year

Amount of award: \$1,500

Fellowship Requirements: Participate in Craig Center Seminars and present one paper in the Spring Semester of the Fellowship. Provide research assistance with one Craig Center project.

Th.M./Ph.D. Research Fellowship

Eligibility: Full-time WTS Th.M. or Ph.D. student.

Tenure of Fellowship: 1 year

Amount of award: \$1,000

Fellowship requirement: Participate in Craig Center Seminars and provide research assistance with one Craig Center project.

M.A.R./M.Div. Research Fellowship

Eligibility: Full-time WTS M.A.R. or M.Div. student

Tenure of Fellowship: 1 year

Amount of award: \$500

Fellowship requirement: Participate in Craig Center Seminars and provide research assistance with one Craig Center project.

1. Cover sheet with the following information: Name; mailing address to be used for future correspondence; telephone and fax numbers; email address; type of fellowship you are applying for. Post-doctoral applicants must also include a brief statement detailing their research goals and the tentative topic that they will present at the Craig Center Seminar.
2. Curriculum Vitae of no more than three pages.
3. Copies of all academic transcripts.
4. Two reference letters.
